THE PÉCKVILLERCHERS-RUN

In 2024, the sports commission, newly appointed after the 2023 municipal elections, revived the Péckvillerchers Run.

Thus, on Sunday, April 28, 2024, the mayor gave the starting signal for the 8th Péckvillerchers Run. In total, 250 runners dared to take on the respective courses, and the best received, as tradition demands, a Péckvillercher from Biwesch Usch. The president of the sports commission was very proud to present the medal to the winner among the men, Luc Scheller, a native of Olm and a former member of the sports commission. His 39 minutes and 29 seconds were not enough to beat the best time of 37 minutes and 51 seconds set in 2013.

The sports commission is therefore proud to welcome very good athletes to Nouspelt and looks forward to every best time set.

The sports commission also aims to support and promote mass sports for young and old to convey the joy of movement to children and adults. The Péckvillerchers Run in Nouspelt offers a great platform for children and adults who have not been doing sports for long to measure

themselves against others for the first time. Therefore, children's races of 650 and 1300 meters and a run of 5.5 km are offered. Some runners who were optimally prepared by Run for Fun Kehlen for this day also registered for the 5.5 km run to participate in a race for the first time. New this year was the run with a dog over a distance of 5.5 km.

The whole event takes place in a great atmosphere in and around Nouspelt and is only possible thanks to the help of the associations Dt Nouspelt, Run for Fun Kehlen, Fanfare Kehlen, Music Keespelt/Meespelt, Capoeira Kehlen, and the many volunteer track marshals and cyclists who are willing to ensure the well-being of all runners on that day.

The date for 2025 is set, and the sports commission is looking forward to welcoming you on Sunday, April 27, 2025, as a spectator or maybe as a runner.
