

HOW ARE THE CONSTRUCTION SITES IN OUR COMMUNITY?

Several construction projects in the municipality are taking longer or have not yet started. This is no coincidence, but has its reasons.

The municipality sets its priorities consciously: it is about improving the quality of life, sustainability, preserving the heritage and supporting the clubs, always within the framework of financial possibilities.

A few examples illustrate this:

- Traffic calming: In some localities, the measures have already been implemented or are being implemented. A major construction project is the introduction of a 30-speed zone in Kiel, which should be completed by the end of the year.
- Kehlen bypass: The project has been submitted to the ministry, and interviews are still planned for this year.
- Revitalization of the village centers: The municipality has purposefully purchased old building materials, such as For example, the "Haff Elcheroth" (now an annex of the municipality) and the "Café Lippert", where work has begun. In Nouspelt, the "Schockweilerhaff" and the "Peickes" house also belong to the municipality but these projects are designed for a longer term.-



Education: The new school in Elmen will open in early 2026. Immediately afterwards, the old school in Kiel will be renovated. The school is scheduled for mid-2027.

- General challenges: The duration of the projects often depends on personnel and financial resources. The municipality relies on long-term planning and small but constant progress.

I ask for your understanding and patience and assure you that we will work together with the citizens to make the municipality even more livable.
